Parents, please remember these important CUSD dress code rules. All clothing shall be neat, clean and acceptable in repair and appearance and shall be worn within the bounds of decency and good taste as appropriate for school.

- Tank tops and/or tops that expose the midriff are not appropriate or acceptable.
- Straps on clothing need to be at least 2 in. wide.
- The students at Liberty are not allowed to wear sandals, flip-flops, or shoes without a heel strap
- Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh or 5 inches above knee - whichever is longer and they must be hemmed.
- Leggings are allowed if over garment reaches 5 inches above knee or mid-thigh - whichever is longer
- Hair which causes undue attention is not acceptable; Unusual colors (kool-aid), mohawks, tails or razor cuts.
- Hats are to be removed in the classroom and office. Any apparel depicting professional sports teams shall not be worn. Only Clovis Unified, colleges or university team logos are acceptable.
