## Important 1<sup>st</sup> Day School Information Packet


Please read and respond to the information in your child's first day packet of materials.

## School Lunch Information



Clovis Unified School District offers a school lunch program at Liberty. Lunch for elementary students is \$2.25 per meal. Breakfast is \$1.00 and is served from 8:00-8:15am. Regular, chocolate or strawberry milk are also available for .40 cents.

You may pay for student meals by putting your money into a student debit account that your child can draw from on a daily basis. The locked drop box for payments is located in the front office at the short front counter. Please place any cash in an envelope with the student's full name (first and last), along with their room number. Envelopes are provided and are by the lock box for your convenience. Checks should be made out to ClovisUSD and do not need to be placed in an envelope. Please write your students name in the memo portion. Both cash and checks are accepted. You may also make payments online through ParentConnect. No money will be accepted in the lunch line.

**We ask that lunches brought after the tardy bell has rung be taken directly to the stage in the MPR. Please, do not interrupt class. We have provided post-its and pens on the right side of the stage to clearly mark the lunch.**

Fall Sports Sign Ups

All students in grades 4-6 are encouraged to come and join a school sports team. Signups for the Fall sports season will be held Monday, August 22 in the MPR during upper grade lunch. Additional signups will continue Tuesday & Wednesday.

Upper grade students may participate in Girls Volleyball (grades 5 & 6), Football (grades 5 & 6), and Cross Country (grades 4,5 & 6)

Fall sports practice will be held after school from 3:15-4:15pm. Football Volleyball and Cross Country begin on Thurs. Aug. 25

Please note: Sports practices are not held on any Wednesday. Students must return a signed Parent Permission Form along with Proof of Insurance and sign a Code of participation form in order to participate. The required forms will be made available to students during signups.

Parent Connection & Mandatory Yearly Forms Packet

It is **mandatory** that all students have their forms completed online by a parent or legal guardian. To access Parent Connect, please visit [www.cusd.com](http://www.cusd.com) and click on the red Parent Connect/yearly forms button on the right hand side of the menu. Once you have logged into Parent Connect, click on the **Annual Verification** link above your child's name. Detailed instructions are provided in the Liberty main office. Parent Connect is provided free of charge and is accessible 24 hours a day, 7 days a week from any smartphone, tablet, desktop or laptop computer with internet access. If needed, please inform the office if you do not have access to a computer. We have made arrangements for you to use one during regular business hours here at school. **You must have an email address to have access to Parent Connect.** Parent Connect also gives you the ability to view school news, attendance, assignments & grades (for grades 2-6) and cafeteria purchases and balances throughout the school year.

**IMPORTANT:** If you do not have your PIN and password, you must email Mrs. Hagenzieker in the main office at [rachelhagenzieker@cusd.com](mailto:rachelhagenzieker@cusd.com) and she will respond to your email with the information you need. This is very important.

ARRIVAL & DISMISSAL TIMES

Supervision begins on campus at 8:00am for students in grades K-6 therefore students who do not ride the bus and those who are not enrolled in Campus Club are not to be on campus before 8:00am. For the safety and well-being of our students, you must adhere to this policy.

Please communicate each day to your student how they are getting home, are they taking the bus, are they going to Campus Club, who is picking them up and where on campus they should meet.

We make every effort to relay messages but clear communication from home is always best.

All students **MUST** go directly home at the end of each school day unless they are directly involved in an after school activity. Siblings are **NOT ALLOWED** to wait at school for brothers &/or sisters who may be involved in an after school activity.

Oops! Dropping off something they forgot?

Once the bell rings at 8:20am, all forgotten lunches, sports equipment, instruments, books or homework now go directly to the stage and not to the office. Post its and pens are available on the stage to mark the item.

Our wonderful Campus Monitors will make sure your child gets their lunch.

Our teachers and students have much to accomplish in the classroom so out of respect for their time and efforts and for the safety of our campus, we thank you for not entering the classrooms or corridors which is against CUSD policy. Thank you

## Student Drop Off & Pick Up Guidelines



The main parking lot is on the corner of Perrin and Liberty Hill Road. This lot has been designated as the bus drop off and pick up area. Traffic is extremely heavy from 8:00am to 8:15am and from 3:00pm to 3:20pm. It is recommended that parents use Liberty Hill Road circle drive (by upper grade wing) and Perrin circle drive (by the basketball courts) during these heavy traffic times. To ensure the safe arrival and departure of all students, please follow these guidelines as you drop off and pick up your child.

### **Never stop or park in the RED BUS LOADING area**

Please park your car in a parking stall and walk to the sidewalk area to drop off or pick up students. Because young children are difficult to see in the rear view mirror-NEVER ALLOW YOUR CHILD TO CROSS THE PARKING LOT OR STREET WITHOUT AN ADULT!

The main lot can be entered from both Perrin and Liberty Hill but check for students crossing at parking lot entrances before entering. The Perrin Circle drive and parking lot has one entrance and one exit only as does the north parking lot on Liberty Hill Road. Please adhere to posted signs. Left hand turns are permitted as long as safety allows.

Never use handicap spaces unless authorized to do so. Cars illegally parked in handicapped spaces will be ticketed and fined. Please be courteous of those who truly are in need of those spaces and not just the convenience of a spot close by.

### **DO NOT USE THE STREET LIBERTY HILL ROAD AS A DROP OFF/PICK UP AREA. THIS IS A RED ZONE!**

Only the circle drives are designated as drop off or pick up areas from 8:00-8:20am and 3:00-3:20pm.

### ***PLEASE, NEVER LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE UNATTENDED IN THE CIRCLE DRIVES AT ANY TIME!***

Drive carefully! Be very aware of students crossing the driveway entrances and exits as they walk home. Your help in providing for the safety of all children is very much appreciated.
