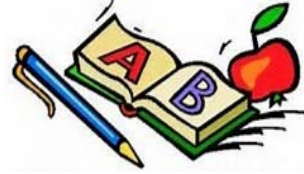

Listed below are the items you **must** bring in order to register your child:

- **Original Birth Certificate or Passport**
- **Proof Of Residence** (Only the following paperwork will be accepted)

Bring only one of the following items:

- Most recent PG&E bill (with your name on it)
- Escrow Papers (less than 45 days from closing)
- Rental/Lease agreement (signed)
- Most recent Water/Sewage/Garbage bill (with your name on it)
- Most recent Paycheck Stub
- Most recent Property Tax payment receipt
- Voter Registration Card
- Certified Copy of the Voter Registration Application Form

If you are living with a family member or friend and it is their name on the proof of residence, they must accompany you to registration to sign a Declaration of Residency and bring their California Driver's License picture ID.

- **Proof Of Completed & Up To Date Immunizations**
 - 5 DTP shots
 - 4 polio (IPV/OPV) immunizations
 - 3 Hepatitis B shots
 - 2 MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) shots
 - 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox) shot

if you are coming from out of the country, you will be given special instructions

Please provide a copy of this completed paperwork to be kept on site

Please Note: You are more than welcome to bring photocopies of all the above items as this will save time in the registration process. However, we do need to actually see the original birth certificate but will gladly accept your photocopy to keep for our records. Thank you!

Kindergarten:

Eligible students turn five on or before September 1, 2017

Transitional Kindergarten:

Eligible students turn five between Sept. 2 and Dec. 2, 2017

Students born within this window are **NOT** eligible for Kindergarten

*** If your child was born outside of the United States and this is their first time in school in the United States, prior to registering you must first call and set up a meeting with Student Services & School Attendance located at our Clovis Unified District Office, on the corner of Herndon and Sunnyside in Clovis. ***

How are classes formed?

Our goal is to create balanced classes. Much thought is put into each student's placement, in every grade, at Liberty. We build classes based on readiness levels (using information from the assessment & previous grades), age (it's nice to have a blend of younger and older students), and gender.

Our Trans-K and Kindergarten classes are half day only with the morning session from 8:15am-11:45am (Wednesdays until 11:00am) and the afternoon session from 11:45am-3:15pm (Wednesdays until 1:40pm).

Parents will have the opportunity at registration to let us know their preference as to morning or afternoon classes. Unfortunately, we are not able to grant each request but do our best with the information we have been given. If you have a special circumstance, please let us know when you register.

In order to meet our overriding goal of building balanced classes, specific teacher requests are not permitted.
