Dress Code Reminders

Parents, please help enforce these regulations

- Tank tops and/or tops that expose the midriff are not appropriate or acceptable.
- Straps on clothing need to be at least 2 in. wide.
- Clothes shall be worn as intended and be sufficient to conceal undergarments, which shall be covered at all times
- The students at Liberty are not allowed to wear sandals, flip-flops, or shoes without a heel strap
- Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh or 5 inches above knee – whichever is longer and they must be hemmed.
- Leggings are allowed if over garment reaches 5 inches above knee or mid-thigh – whichever is longer
- Hair which causes undue attention is not acceptable
- Hats are to be removed in the classroom and office. Any apparel depicting professional sports teams shall not be worn.
- Only team logos from Clovis Unified schools, colleges or universities are acceptable to wear to school.
