Open Enrollment Transfers

Open Enrollment forms for the 2018-2019 school year may be picked up and/or submitted in the Liberty office or at the Student Services and School Attendance office until November 1, 2017.

Students currently on Intra-district transfers are required to apply for Open Enrollment to continue enrollment next year in their current school of choice.

Intra-district transfers are valid for 1 year only and may not be renewed due to Board Policy #2209. Open Enrollment applications are available for Clovis Unified residents only. If you have recently moved out of the Liberty boundary area, you must apply for an Intra-district transfer to remain at Liberty for the remainder of the year. You may also apply for an Open Enrollment at the same time.
