Building Classes for 2018-2019

Can you believe we are already talking about next year?! Student placement is a careful and diligent process at Liberty which endeavors to create cohesive and balanced classrooms. Teachers work as a grade level team along with administration to place students in the appropriate educational setting. If you feel your child has a special learning consideration, please submit a letter to the principal explaining your child's learning needs. Every effort is made to accommodate every child's learning needs, regardless if you submit a letter. Remember, **absolutely no request for specific teachers will be considered.** Please submit all letters to the front office before Friday, May 4th. Also, knowing where you will be residing next year will help us build classes.

Please complete the form that will come home with your student on Monday April 16th and return by Friday, April 20th. Thank you.

In May, Liberty begins state testing. The state test is administered to students in grades 3-6, utilizing an online platform. Your child will take the test on a computer. Liberty's testing window begins in the beginning of May and goes to the end of May. You can help your student by making sure he/she has a healthy breakfast, packed with protein, at the beginning of each test day, and that your child gets plenty of rest. Please do not schedule appointments during your student's testing session. Make it a habit of consulting classroom newsletters and/or the Hawklane Calendar for specific testing information before you schedule appointments.

Dress Code Reminders

As our weather warms up, please remember these dress code rules.

- Tank tops are not appropriate or acceptable.
- Straps on clothing need to be at least 2 in. wide.
- The students at Liberty are not allowed to wear flip-flops, shoes or sandals without a heel strap
- Shorts must be no shorter than mid-thigh and must be hemmed.
- Leggings are allowed if over garment reaches 4 inches above knee
