### As the weather warms up

**Please remember these CUSD dress code rules:**

- ◆ Tops that expose the midriff are not acceptable.
- ◆ No Camouflage prints.
- ◆ No frayed or unhemmed jeans or shorts.
- ◆ Shoulder straps on tops need to be at least 2 inches wide.
- ◆ Shoes must have a heel or back strap, no slides or flip-flops.
- ◆ Shorts length must be 5 inches above knee or at least mid-thigh - whichever is longer, and they must be hemmed.
- ◆ Leggings are allowed if over garment reaches 5 inches above knee or mid-thigh – whichever is longer.
- ◆ Hair which causes undue attention is not acceptable, such as unusual colors (kool-aid or dyed hair colors), mohawks, tails or razor cuts.
- ◆ Hats are to be removed indoors.
- ◆ Any apparel depicting professional sports teams or logos are not acceptable.
