Principal's Message

Hello Skyeeeeehawks,

My dad was an educator. He was a teacher and a principal in Clovis Unified School District. I grew up watching how my dad approached his career. I learned what he believed about teaching and leading a school. He and I spent countless hours talking about his philosophy of education. He told me things like: "Raising children to be contributing members of a free and democratic society is the most important task we do as a community", "the family is our country's most important institution and schools have been created to support families"; "a child's right to a quality education is non-negotiable". He had a lot of beliefs as an educator. These are just a few that guided and motivated him. My point is NOT that we should believe what my dad believed. My dad was a very successful educator, and he is the reason why I do what I do today. The main reason why he was successful is because his beliefs gave him a purpose. He went above and beyond the call of duty. I watched him get up each morning with passion and energy when he went to work, as if he was going to some place special. He got better at what he did not because his boss told him to; he got better because he believed in what he was doing. The most important lesson I learned from my father is that when you have a purpose, you're more likely to do your job to the best of your ability. I also learned that when your purpose involves helping people, you strive to be better because you want others to be better. In my father's world, his purpose involved helping families and students. My father had a greater sense of fulfillment when he helped students accomplish their goals. And he wanted students to have a purpose because he realized how important that is for everyone's success.

This month's Positivity Project Character Strength is *Purpose*. In the classroom, students are more successful when they know the why behind the what. Because this is essentially for our students' growth, let's work together as adults to explain the purpose for *school*: Why going to school *every day* is important; why students working collaboratively with peers is so valuable; the reason behind why we work so hard daily to learn how to read, write, and solve math problems together. What we do as a Liberty community is extremely important and very valuable for our students and families, and there is a lot of good reasons why adults work together. Occasionally, even adults need to be reminded of their purpose for working together. When adults have a shared purpose, students are more likely to go to school with a purpose and become a better version of themselves.
