- Has a greater sense of belonging (improving social-emotional health)
- Feels less lonely, less stress, less anxiety
- Is more successful academically (especially if connected closely to the school)
- Has a greater sense of empathy
- Is more able to bring fun into the lives of all members of the family
- Are better communicators
- Is able to adjust to change in much healthier manner

In Clovis Unified, schools are used to create healthy strong communities, and this has always been an important goal for Liberty. Programs and events are just two ways we attempt to create community.
